Hunterdon Land Trust Farmers' Market Open Sundays

FLEMINGTON – Hunterdon Land Trust Farmers' Market is open every Sunday through Nov. 21 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. with about 25 local farmers and vendors offering an array of organic produce; all-natural beef, chicken and pork; fresh-baked breads; cave-ripened cheeses; honey; pies; native plants; fresh-cut flowers; locally roasted coffee; milk and more.

The market is located on the Dvoor Farm, 111 Mine St., Flemington. Seniors and our more vulnerable population are encouraged to visit the market between 9-9:30 a.m. Masks are optional.

The following farmers and vendors attending the market during the year are:

Apple Ridge Farm: Artisan breads and hearty pastries.

AquaSprout Farms: Fresh vegetables including lettuce, Swiss chard, kale and tomatoes.

Barking Good Bakery: Handmade, healthy dog and cat treats.

Bobolink Dairy and Bakehouse: Breads and a variety of cheeses – including cave-ripened cheddar, baulolino and drum, and grass-fed beef.



Bubbly Goat: Goat's milk skin care products including body cream, lotions, soaps and scrubs.

Burek by Zeni: Homemade bureks – phyllo dough stuffed with meats, cheese and vegetables.

Cabbage Throw Farm at Comeback Farm: Organic vegetables.

Catalina Empanada: Baked empanadas.

Fieldstone Coffee Roasters: Coffee (including beans and ground), teas, coffee and tea drinks and more.

Fired Up Flatbread Co.: Food truck serving pizza, pastries and beverages.

Griggstown Farm: Eggs, poultry, poultry products, mushrooms, honey, pies and more.

Gorgeous Goat Farm: Creamy chevre, 100 percent goat's milk feta, bottled goat's milk and handmade ceramics.

Kleinhans Farm – An assortment of beef products. (alternating weeks)

Neshanic Station Apiaries: Raw honey, handcrafted soaps, beeswax candles, lip balm and more.

Norz Hill Farm: A large assortment of fresh vegetables and fruit. Also offering milk and some beef products. Norz Hill Farm accepts SNAP NJ WIC and the Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program.

Pickle Licious: A variety of pickles, olives and sun-dried tomatoes.

Pretty Bird Farm: Locally grown flowers and cut flowers.

Purely Farm: Eggs, pastured pork, artisan sausages and turkey.

River Lea House: Assortment of garlics including cooking garlic, hummus, black garlic, vegan butter, garlic scape pesto and garlic butter.

Sweet Valley Farms: Seasonal fruits and vegetables including corn, eggplants and tomatoes. (starting July)

Toadshade Wildflower Farm: Native plants and seeds, including wildflowers, shrubs, ferns, vines, and small trees. (Until end of June, and September)

Two Barn Farm: A large variety of seasonal produce and popcorn.

Unionville Vineyards: A fine variety of local, award-winning wines.

Untamed Ferments: Natural fermented beverages including kombucha, kvass and switchel.

Will's Amazing Vegan Burgers: Frozen, home-made vegan burgers that are soy-free, dairy-free and gluten-free, and sauces including sun-dried tomato ketchup. (alternating weeks)

Wildspawn Mushrooms: An array of mushrooms including shiitake, lions mane chestnut, white beech, king oyster, blue & yellow oyster mixes and pheasant back mushrooms.

Woods Edge Farm: Llama and alpaca products, honey, and yak meat.

Most farmers accept credit cards. Parking is free and easily accessible.
