

# Welcome to the Kugler Woods Preserve

The Kugler Woods Preserve covers 220 acres of woodlands which are home to a 10 foot wet season waterfall, and spectacular views of the Delaware River. Its forests date back to Revolutionary War times when they provided timber for the boats used by George Washington in the historic 1776 crossing of the Delaware River. These wooded hills have many sugar maples and at one time were home to Hunterdon County's only gravity-assisted maple syrup operation. An additional 600 acres of parkland is close by including Bulls Island Recreation Area, part of the Delaware and Raritan Canal State Park, which offers camping, fishing, canoeing, interpretive programming, bicycling, and a public boat launch.

The Hunterdon Land Trust works with the NJ Division of Parks and Forestry and Kingwood Township to develop trails and public education programs, as well as species' habitat restoration. The Hunterdon Land Trust is a nonprofit organization working to preserve and protect the farms, forests and fields of Hunterdon County. ## Kugler Woods Preserve Rules:

- \* Leave no trace: carry out your trash.
- \* Pets allowed if kept on a leash under 6 feet long.
- \* Hunting is permitted. Go to [www.nj.gov/dep/fgw](http://www.nj.gov/dep/fgw) for information.
- \* Stay on marked trails.
- \* Alcoholic beverages, camping, fires and motorized vehicles are prohibited.

**Falls Trail :** This ¼ mile trail is steep and rocky. At its end is a wide 10 foot wet season waterfall. Moderately difficult.

**Directions :** Entrance to the property is across from the parking area on the river side of Route 29 directly across the river from Point Pleasant, Pennsylvania. The parking area is 5.1 miles north of Stockton and 7.1 miles south of Frenchtown. It is also 1.8 miles north of Bulls Island Recreational Area.

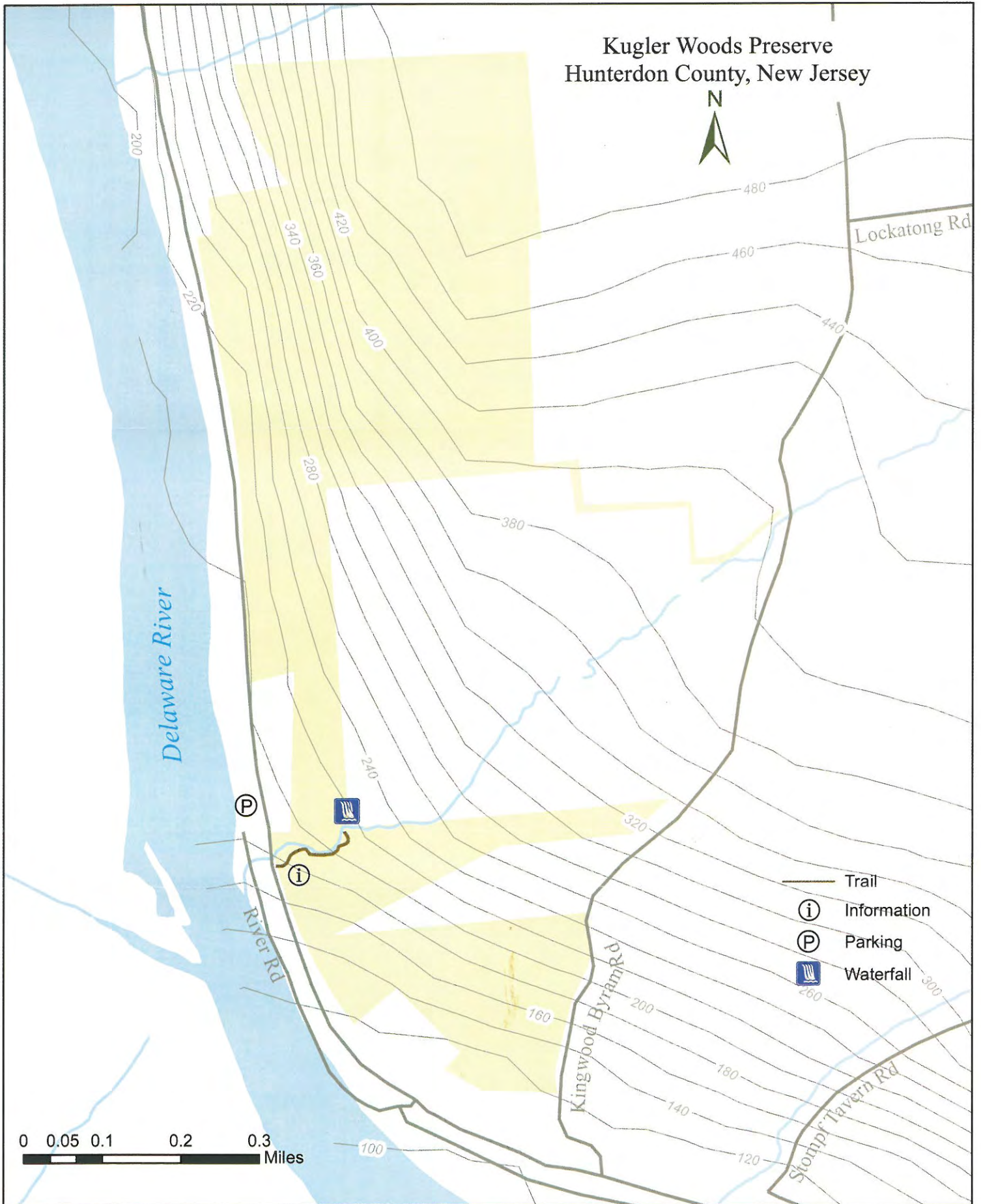
